It said with indignation.






We work to pick the golden fruit

Golden fruit and its whereabouts!



GLOSSARY



Explorers: Well known for their bravery, heroism and honor. When Explorers meet new people in far away places, they do so on behalf of the King of Naroo.



Lapstrake: (Lap-Stray-K) These ships are the main form of transportation in and around Naroo. It's said that their magic comes from the Forest Spirits, and each ship has a personality all its own.



Golden Fruit: Delicious fruits that are both sweet and tangy.



Enchanted Forest: Once thought to only be the home of wild fruit and small animals, the wood harvested from the trees here have special powers.



Magic Driving Wand: Also carved from enchanted wood, this wand is used to drive your Lapstrake. Its powers are limited in comparison to a Wizard's Wand.



Planet Moon: The largest planet in orbit around Naroo, this moon can be seen during the daylight hours.



Spiked Trees: Cone shaped trees that have very thin branches. They are very difficult and dangerous to climb.



Royal Marmalade: A delicious jam made from Golden Fruit. Its taste is both tangy and sweet, with a hint of tiny carbonated bubbles that tickle your taste buds.




Royal Parchment: The wax seal on this paper scroll signifies it came from the high office of the Naroo Kingdom.



Sailboat Harbor: A protected area of water, shielded from the waves and wind of the ocean. In the warm seasons many Naroo children learn to sail here.




Lantern: These candle lit lamps are found all over the kingdom, they do much more than shed light on darkness. Messages can be sent from lantern to lantern.
